A graduate in Enology and Agricultural Industries from Mendoza's Juan Agustín Maza University, Alejandro Canovas has extensive experience with both traditional wineries and those on the experimental edge. His work covers multiple countries including France, Italy, and Argentina.

With more than two decades of experience, Canovas became the first enologist at Bodega Vistalba in 2001. He has also done work with other Argentinean wineries including Santa Gimena, Martin's Domingo, Dolium, Trapiche, and Barberis. At Vistalba, the core philosophy is masterful blending. For Canovas, this translates to a philosophy of working closely with the vineyard manager to ensure that individual lots and varietals are continually monitored so that when they come to the winery, he can begin the artful work of sampling.
