Bodega Vistalba

Bodega Vistalba was founded by Carlos Pulentu in 2001. Vistalba crafts the blends identified as Corte A, Corte B and Corte C, each characteristic of the terroir and obtained from the best grapes of that harvest. The blends are produced with great aging potential in mind. They are made with Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Bonarda grapes from estate vineyards in Vistalba, Luján de Cuyo. The climate conditions and the labors performed in each of the vineyard blocks define the structures of the grapes to be used in the individual blend. The grapes are fermented separately in concrete vessels. Each blend is finalized after fermentation, and moved into French oak barrels to start the aging process.
