Aromas of pain grille, mineral, violets, Asian spices, and assorted black and blue fruits set the stage for a dense, structured, savory, impeccably balanced wine that will benefit from another 3-4 years of cellaring to reveal its full potential. Drink it from 2014 to 2024."*
