2013 RESERVA PETIT VERDOT

The Petit Verdot grapes for this select wine are handpicked from Block 34 in our vineyards at the heart of the Uco Valley in Mendoza. Vines in this region face harsh winters and warm summers with mild days and very cold nights. The vines are planted in a rocky, sandy loam with medium to low fertility, good drainage, and low organic material content and salinity levels.

The 2013 Reserva Petit Verdot is an intense ruby red with glints of deep plum, and displays herbal aromas with subtle notes of tobacco and cocoa. On the palate you are met with abundant stone fruit flavors of wild plum and inklings of minerality. Silky tannins and a pleasing medium body mouthfeel culminate with a pleasing, lengthy finish.
